

# Phonics Phones

- 💡 Do you have students who need to work on fluency and inflection in their reading? Have them listen to themselves reading into a phonics phone.
- 💡 Give a phonics phone to a child who's trying to memorize a poem or lines in a play, and tell him to read the lines into the phone. It's amazing what a boost to memorizing this can be!
- 💡 If some of your students tend to want to read out loud, encourage them to "whisper read" into phonics phones. You'll cut down on the noise level during silent reading.
- 💡 Trouble with tattletales? Leave a phonics phone on your desk and tell kids to leave their messages on the phone—you'll pick them up later!
